# Curriculum Steps:

1. Insert correct teacher names, class, month and year.
2. Insert themes, books and songs.

Make sure they fit in the box, if need be make the font smaller DO NOT change the box size

3. Change Number for correct month.
4. Merging Cells: To Merge cells or Unmerge **Highlight the boxes** and right click the mouse. Click on 'Merge Cells' or 'Split Cells' to make space for two day projects. Do this before you place projects in if possible.
5. Project font size is **12 Bold & Underlined** what they are learning is **Size 9 Bold**
6. Font Colors....Feel free to change the font colors to spice up the curriculum and make is cute, we all love cute looking curriculum.
7. Adding Photos:
  - First Select your photos offline (google.com image search is the best way to find cute pictures)
  - Crop Photos in photo shop to cut out the borders and excess picture to maximize size on curriculum
  - Add Photo by using 'INSERT FILE'
  - Highlight Photo and shrink to usable size (if nessisary)
  - Highlight Photo and USING IMAGE tools select "In front of Text" this allows you to move the photo wherever you want, twist it or move to beside the project title. This also prevents the photo from making your boxes extra big and causing your curriculum to go on two pages.
